

## City of Richmond Cleaning Water Shut-Off Valves

Over the next few days and early into next week, the City of Richmond will be cleaning and flushing the water shut-off valves throughout the complex.

Unfortunately, this process will result in silt and sediment entering the water supply lines causing the water to become brown with a dirty appearance.

There is no cause for alarm in that no bacteria have entered the lines. However, it is recommended owners flush their water lines by opening all taps (e.g. kitchen, washroom and bathtub tap) and allow to run for several minutes. This will ensure any sediment that has accumulated in your incoming supply line is thoroughly flushed out and the water returns to its clear, drinkable state.
